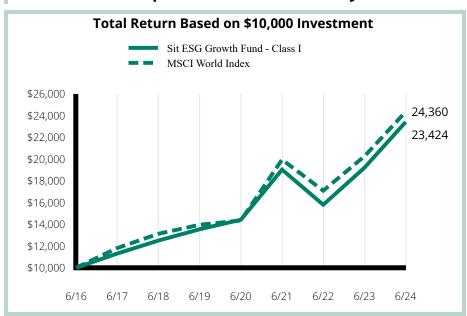

How did the Fund perform in the past 12 months and what affected its performance?

For the 12-month period ended June 30, 2024, the Sit ESG Growth Fund - Class I shares returned +21.90%. The MSCI World Index's return was +20.19%. During the period, both industry allocation and stock selection contributed to outperformance. The Fund benefited from an overweight position in the semiconductors & semiconductor equipment industry. Here, holdings such as NVIDIA (+192%), Broadcom (+88%), significantly outperformed the MSCI World Index. The Fund also benefited from stock selection in the capital goods industry, where positions in Trane Technologies (+74%) and BAE Systems (+45%) outpaced the benchmark. The largest detractor to returns during the period was stock selection pharmaceuticals within the biotechnology & life sciences industry. In this group, the Fund had no exposure to the industry's best-performing stock, Eli Lilly (+94%), which detracted from performance.
